Our initiatives address often-overlooked endeavors, such as advocating for trail access and trailer parking, offering silver buckles for children's horse shows, and establishing disaster relief funds.

14th Sonoma County Horse Council Equus Awards Gala and Fundraiser

The 14th Sonoma County Horse Council Equus Awards Gala and Fundraiser is a celebration of our joyous 30-year journey supporting the bond shared between Sonoma County's horse lovers, horse-related business owners and equids themselves. This year's coveted Equus Award acknowledges the particularly outstanding contributions of four individuals and one horse to the Sonoma County equestrian community. Our elegant event will be held at the Friedman Center in Santa Rosa, California on May 11, 2024.

Ten years ago, the Sonoma County Horse Council (SCHC) joined forces with Sonoma State University and conducted an economic impact study of the county's horse community. Economist consultants estimated that the equine industry generated \$613 million annually for Sonoma County businesses, supported over 7,700 jobs, and provided over \$11 million in annual local tax revenues for Sonoma County - all of which create beneficial "ripple-effect" contributions to our local economy.

Sponsors help to support future survey work, which can provide information for strategic changes that can be used to improve business critical to the sustainability of the horse community. The SCHC has commissioned an updated Economic Impact Study to be completed this year.

Sponsors also help to make other important SCHC activities possible, including horse-trailering training, governmental advocacy for trail development and enhancement, support for youth programs and events, disaster and emergency training and relief, microchipping, vaccination, and gelding clinics, and promoting other horse-related organizations and businesses.
